

**Benjamin Djulbegovic, M.D., Ph.D.**

Dr. Djulbegovic is Professor of Medicine and Oncology at the H. Lee Moffitt Cancer Center & Research Institute at the University of South Florida in Tampa, Florida. His major academic research interests are in the areas of evidence-based medicine, decision analysis, clinical reasoning, systematic reviews and meta-analysis, the ethics of clinical trials, practice guidelines, outcomes research, and the impact of randomized trials. Dr. Djulbegovic has taught extensively on this subject within the United States and internationally. Most recently, his research has focused on understanding the relationship between the ethical precepts and the innovative successes in clinical research. Dr. Djulbegovic has published more than 100 papers in peer-reviewed journals, 80 abstracts, and the 2 books *Reasoning and Decision Making in Hematology* and *Decision Making in Oncology: Evidence-Based Management*. In 1999 his work on equipoise, the fundamental principle on which clinical advances are being made, received the Thomas C Chalmers Award (second prize) of The Cochrane Collaboration. Dr. Djulbegovic is a Founder and Editor of the journal *Evidence-based Oncology*, which recently merged with *Cancer Treatment Reviews*. He serves on the editorial teams of the Cochrane Haematological Malignancies Group and several other peer-reviewed journals. He also serves on National Institutes of Health (NIH) review panels and is a scientific reviewer for numerous medical journals. Dr. Djulbegovic's research has been funded both by the NIH and industry.
