Dr. London is Associate Professor of Philosophy and an executive member of the Center for the Advancement of Applied Ethics at Carnegie Mellon University. In March 2005 he was awarded a New Directions Fellowship from the Andrew W. Mellon Foundation to pursue his research interests at the intersection of decision theory, economics, and research ethics.

Dr. London is co-editor of *Ethical Issues in Modern Medicine*, 6th edition (McGraw Hill 2002). His research focuses primarily on foundational issues in research ethics, including issues in clinical trial design and the conduct of international research. Dr. London's papers have appeared in *The Hastings Center Report*, *The American Journal of Bioethics*, *Bioethics*, *The Journal of Medicine and Philosophy*, *Clinical Trials*, and *Statistical Methods in Medical Research*, among others.
