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Dr. Swart is Senior Medical Epidemiologist in the Cancer Division of the Medical Research Council's (MRC) Clinical Trials Unit in London, UK.

After graduating from St. Bartholomew's Hospital, University of London, Dr. Swart trained in general internal medicine and human immunodeficiency virus (HIV). She is a member of the Royal College of Physicians and was awarded an MRC Training Fellowship in Clinical Epidemiology to study for a master's degree in epidemiology while coordinating the Anglo-French Concorde trial.

Currently, Dr. Swart is responsible for MRC's program of clinical trials in gynecological cancer and is a member of the UK National Cancer Research Network's Gynaecological Cancer Clinical Studies Group and the international Gynaecological Cancer Intergroup. Within these groups, she works with national and international collaborators to develop a long-term strategy for trials in gynecological cancer. Dr. Swart has written papers on clinical trials and pharmacoepidemiology.
