Dr. Thompson is Associate Professor of Medicine at Harvard Medical School and Director of the Medical Intensive Care Unit at the Massachusetts General Hospital in Boston. He is a clinical trialist and serves as Medical Director of the Clinical Coordinating Center of the National Institute of Health's Acute Respiratory Distress Syndrome (ARDS) Clinical Network.
