Dr. Wittes is President of Statistics Collaborative, Inc. She is a member of many advisory committees, including a large number of data and safety monitoring boards for randomized clinical trials sponsored by both industry and government. Among other positions, Dr. Wittes has served as Chief of the Biostatistics Research Branch, National Heart, Lung, and Blood Institute, National Institutes of Health. Her research focuses on the design and analysis of randomized clinical trials. Dr. Wittes is a Fellow of the American Statistical Association and the American Association for the Advancement of Science and an elected member of the International Statistical Institute. She is Past President of The International Biometric Society, Eastern North American Region, (1995) and The Society for Clinical Trials (2001). From 1990 through 1995 Dr. Wittes served as Editor-in-Chief of *Controlled Clinical Trials*. She received her A.B. degree in mathematics from Radcliffe College (1964) and her Ph.D. degree from the Department of Statistics at Harvard University (1970).
